



## **Policies**

• Arrival Time. Weddings are scheduled on the hour. One hour is allowed for a single ceremony. Two hours are allowed for a ceremony with a reception. If your reserved time is 2:00 - 3:00, you should arrive at 2:00 and be out before 3:00 for the next ceremony. If you arrive dressed, we will begin on the hour. If you need to change, we will begin when you are dressed. Brides generally arrive with their hair, makeup, and nails done; slipping into their wedding attire takes only a few minutes.

• **Parking.** Parking is available next to the chapel. Access is on Munich Strasse between the 2nd and 3rd buildings on the right.

• **Counting Guests.** Other than the bride and groom, all men, women, infants, and other children are regarded as guests. All children must be accompanied by and properly supervised by an adult at all times.

• Methods of Payment. We accept checks, money orders, and cash only. We do not accept any credit card payments. Pay to: Alpine Wedding Chapel, P.O. Box 1343, Helen, 30545.

Reservations. To reserve use of our facilities on a date & time of your choice, a deposit received in our office is required. Ceremony = \$100 deposit; Ceremony + Reception = \$200 deposit.

• **Deposits.** A \$100 nonrefundable, nontransferable deposit

received will guarantee your choice of date and time of ceremony. An additional \$100 nonrefundable, nontransferable deposit is required for a reception. If you change your reservation for any reason, the remainder of the balance must be paid before the date and time is guaranteed again. No monies or deposits paid for change of date is refundable. If you schedule for a 3rd or more time and date, you will pay the full amount for each rescheduling of ceremony and/or reception with no money refundable. No money paid for deposits is refundable and no money paid for deposits is refundable and no money paid for rescheduling is refundable.

• **Bubbles.** Please check bubbles in at the office when you arrive. They will be distributed at the appropriate time after the ceremony. Neither rice nor birdseed are allowed at any time on our premises. Bubbles make beautiful photographs!

• **Cameras.** No still, digital, or video cameras, are allowed at any time inside any building of the Alpine Wedding Chapel. Additional sets of wedding pictures may be purchased in the office on the day of the wedding.

• **Candles**. The unity candle service is included in some ceremonies. Souvenir hand-carved unity candles are available at an additional charge; one is included at no charge in Package 6.

• Lodging. Call the Helen-White County Convention & Visitors Bureau at 1-800-858-8027 for current information on honeymoon suites, motels, cabins, condos, chalets, etc. Also, you may request their Helen-White County Travel Guide. See <a href="https://www.helenga.org">www.helenga.org</a>.


• Marriage License. A valid Georgia marriage license is required for us to perform any ceremony.

• Items brought to the Chapel. We are not responsible for any items brought to our facilities. No additional decorations are permitted.

• Attendants. No attendants are allowed in the Little Chapel. 10 seated guests are allowed. Examples of attendants are father of bride, bridesmaids, groomsmen, flower girl, ring bearer, etc.





# Frequently Asked Questions

# Frequently Asked Last Minute Questions

Please review the following questions and answers before you arrive for your wedding.

- What time should we arrive? One hour is allowed for a single ceremony. Two hours are allowed for a ceremony with reception. If your reserved time is 2:00 – 3:00, you should arrive at 2:00 and be out before 3:00 for the next ceremony. If you arrive dressed, we will begin on the hour. If you need to change, we will begin when you are dressed. Brides generally arrive with their hair, makeup, and nails done; slipping into their wedding attire should not take more than 15 minutes.
- Where do we park? Parking is available next to the chapel.
- **Do we have a rehearsal?** *No, but directions and adequate prompts are given prior to the ceremony.*
- **Can we bring cameras?** *No cameras (still, digital, or video) are allowed at any time inside any building of the Alpine Wedding Chapel. Outdoor photography may be done before & after your reserved time.*
- **Do attendants, children, and babies count as guests?** Other than the bride and the groom, all men, women, infants, and other children count as guests.
- If I arrange a carriage, what time shall I tell the carriage to pick us up after the ceremony? 15 minutes before the end of your scheduled time to ensure that we are able to take pictures of your leaving on a carriage.
- Where do attendants dress before the ceremony? Attendants and all other guests should arrive dressed for the ceremony. Small dressing rooms are provided for only the bride and groom.
- Who can give the bride away? The bride's father or other adult representative of the bride's father. It is inappropriate for children to give their mother away; however, occasionally, an older child escorts his mother down the aisle.
- Can we have a champagne toast? No, we do not have a liquor license and there is a brown bag ordinance in Helen that prevents any spirits from being served or consumed on our premises.
- Can we have attendants? Witnesses are no longer required in Georgia. But, if you wish, you may have attendants in the Garden Room or Chapel Ceremonies within reason. A <u>maximum</u> of 5 (2 on each side + Father) is allowed in the Garden Room and 7 (3 on each side + Father) in the Chapel.

Area Maps No attendants are allowed in the Little Chapel; it is too small.

- Do you have a place for the guest book? A bride may bring a guest book if she wishes. The desk in the foyer of the office building may be used if the ceremony is in the Little Chapel or Garden Room. A brass guest registry stand is provided in the Chapel.
- **Do you box up leftover food from the reception?** Food is always plentiful. Only leftover cake, if any, is boxed up for the bride & groom. As with any other buffet, all other food remains the property of the person who prepared it and is not boxed up as a "doggie bag".
- Do we need to provide ushers and servers? No, no ushers or servers are required.
- Can we bring our own minister? No, we do not allow visiting ministers to be in charge of the ceremony. However, if he/she wishes to offer a prayer, this would be welcomed.
- Can we keep the flowers (bouquets & boutonnieres) that you provide? No, we have flowers for bride & groom to use here only.
- Can my flower girl use real flower petals? No, they may stain the carpet; silk petals are required.
- Can the florist deliver my fresh flowers? No, we are only open by appointment and may not be open to receive them. Further, we have no space to store such items.
- Can I provide my own decorations? No, time is not allowed for exchanging decorations.
- If I bring non-food items (cake topper, toasting glasses, napkins, etc.) for the reception, when do I bring them? We provide these items, but if you want to use your own, bring them at the time of the wedding and have them opened and ready for immediate use.
- Can I choose my own music? You may bring 1 or 2 love songs on CD. All other music is traditional music appropriate for a lovely wedding and is provided for your enjoyment.
- How long can we wait on guests or wedding party members who are late? *Not more than 15 minutes.*
- What special provisions are made for small children? The Chapel is not designed for children. If, however, a child attends, he/she should be very carefully supervised & disciplined by a responsible adult assigned to him/her to ensure the reverence & dignity of the occasion. <u>All</u> persons are expected to behave respectfully and maturely while attending weddings & receptions at the chapel.
- What is the ceremony like? We perform only non-denominational, Christian ceremonies. This covenant ceremony ensures the dignity and spirituality of the event. See a copy of this ceremony on our website. Please do not ask us to omit references to God, Jesus, death, eternity, forever, etc.

## MARRIAGE LICENSE



#### To Apply for a Valid Georgia Marriage License:

Actual application for the marriage license is made in person at the marriage license division of the county's probate court. Each applicant must bring two valid forms of identification. Both bride and groom must be 18 years old to apply without parental consent. You must fill out a brief form. The license is issued at the time of application, and there is no waiting period before the marriage can take place. Georgia residents may apply in any GA county. Non-GA residents must apply in the county where the marriage is to be performed.




